The NY Environmental STEM Institute is an intensive, residential STEM program for students aged 17–21, and will be held at federal and non-federal sites in the NYC area. There is also a paid job opportunity as outlined in the Fact Sheet. There is no fee to apply. If selected NHEC will provide a scholarship that covers all major costs of the Institute, as itemized in the Fact Sheet. The Institute is open to all, and applicants from every race, gender, ethnicity, etc. are welcome to apply. See the “Fact Sheet” and “Application Information: How to Apply” for specifics on the Institute and application process. NHEC reserves the right to make changes to the Institute, including revisions to the curriculum. If selected, students will be notified and given further information. NHEC can only provide Institute scholarships to eligible/qualified students up to the limits of available funding.
